Introduction: The "No-Guessing" Approach

Success doesn't require you to be a content machine or a master salesperson. It requires a system that removes the guesswork.

The **Minimal Effort AI Growth System** leverages two core principles:

1. **Ready-Made AI Content:** We use specific prompts to eliminate the time you spend staring at a blank screen.
2. **The GPN Advantage:** We focus every message on the fact that a professional sales team handles the work, and a funding program can cover business-building expenses for qualified members.

This eBook gives you the exact AI prompts to act as your "consistent messaging engine," allowing you to remain a "friendly connector" in just 20 minutes a day.

Phase 1: The Attraction Engine

1. The "Social Shortcut" (Comment Before You Post) Before you post, use this prompt to leave high-value comments in other groups. This "warms up" the algorithm and attracts people to your profile without pitching.

Copy/Paste Prompt: **Role:** Social media engagement expert. **Goal:** I am a member of GPN, where a professional sales team handles presentations and enrollments for me. **Instruction:** Create 3 sample comments I can use under other people's posts in home business groups that: 1. Sound natural and friendly (peer-to-peer). 2. Add genuine value or insight to their post. 3. Hint at my unique system (pro sales team + funding) without naming it directly, to encourage people to click my profile. 4. Keep it to 1–3 short sentences.

2. The 3-Post Attraction Framework : Stop guessing what to write. This single prompt generates the only three types of posts you need: 1. **Curiosity** (hints at a change), 2. **Experience** (shares a personal shift), and 3. **Perspective** (challenges a belief).

Copy/Paste Prompt: **Role:** Social content strategist for home-based entrepreneurs. **Tone:** Conversational, calm, non-salesy. **Instruction:** Write three short social media posts for someone building income from home using a low-pressure system. **Create:** 1. **One Curiosity Post:** Hint at a change without explaining it fully. 2. **One Experience Post:** Share a personal shift in mindset or routine (not just a success story). 3. **One Perspective Post:** Challenge a common belief about "hustle" or "hard work." **Rules:** No links. No pitching. No explaining the business mechanics yet. Keep each post under 3 sentences.

2. The "Fast Track" Link Option: If a prospect asks for information immediately or wants to browse on their own, do not gatekeep. Send them your GPN Member Landing Page.

Script: *"I'm happy to share. You can see the full overview and request a free consultation here: <https://residualincomesuccessplatform.com/MEMBERID>"*

3. The "Gentle Nudge" (Non-Pushy Follow-Up) : If you sent a video or link and haven't heard back, use this prompt. It assumes "positive intent".

Copy/Paste Prompt: **Role:** Helpful consultant, not a salesperson. **Tone:** Respectful, light, assumes positive intent. I shared a short overview about a work-from-home income system where sales are done for you. They said "I'll take a look" two days ago and haven't replied since. **Instruction:** Write 3 short, friendly follow-up messages that: 1. Sound natural and are not salesy. 2. Check in to see if they had a chance to visit the link. 3. Remind them it's a no-cost, no-pressure way to explore.

3. The "2-Minute Invite" (Reconnection Script) : Use this to reach out to friends or old contacts. The goal is not to sell, but to simply ask if they are open to seeing a video.

Copy/Paste Prompt: **Role:** Friendly connector, not a salesperson. **Tone:** Warm and casual. **Instruction:** Write a message to a personal contact I haven't talked to in a while. 1. Start by catching up briefly. 2. Mention that I found a simple system that helps people earn income from home where a professional team does the sales work and a funding program can cover expenses for qualified members. 3. End with a soft, no-pressure question: "Would you like to see a short video?"

Phase 2: The Power Hour Lite Routine

The Engine of the System. You do not need to work all day. You only need to execute the **Power Hour Lite** routine 3 times a week. It takes just 20 minutes per session.

The 20-Minute Checklist:

1. **Send 2 Invites:** Use the "2-Minute Invite" script (Text/Messenger).
2. **Reply to Interest:** Respond to comments or DMs using the scripts below.
3. **Post 1 Update:** Share a short story using the "3-Post Framework" from Phase 1: The Attraction Engine.

1. From Public Comment to Private DM : When someone comments "Curious" or "Info", your goal is to acknowledge them publicly and move to a private message (DM) immediately.

Copy/Paste Prompt: **Role:** Friendly conversation coach. **Tone:** Warm, human, pressure-free. **Instruction:** Someone commented 'curious' on my post about simplifying income-building. Write a short DM to start a conversation. 1. Do not pitch. 2. Do not explain the business or system yet. 3. Ask one natural question to continue the conversation. **Format:** 2-3 short sentences.

Phase 3: The Qualification Engine

1. **AI as Your "Calm Sorting Assistant"** : Use this prompt to paste in the chat history and let AI tell you exactly where the person stands without the "hope" or "hype" filter.

Copy/Paste Prompt: **Role:** My calm business assistant. **Goal:** I am using the GPN Residual Income Success Plan, where sales are done for me and a funding option can cover my business building expenses at no cost to me. Help me understand this prospect's true level of interest so I don't push too hard or wait too long. **Instruction:** Based on the conversation pasted below: 1. Is this person Curious (needs info), Interested (asking specific questions), or Ready (wants to start)? 2. Suggest 2 short, natural clarifying questions I can ask to see if they are ready for a consultation. **Conversation** : [PASTE THEIR MESSAGES HERE].

2. **The 3 Clarifying Questions** : Before you send a link, ask one of these questions to let the prospect "qualify themselves".

The Script:

1. *"What specifically caught your attention about the post?"*
2. *"What are you hoping might change if you found the right income stream?"*
3. *"Are you actively looking for a solution right now, or just browsing?"*

3. Reading the Signals (Green, Yellow, Red) : Use this prompt to determine your immediate next step: **Pipeline** (Green), **Nurture** (Yellow), or **Release** (Red).

Copy/Paste Prompt: **Role:** Sales qualification expert. **Instruction:** Analyze the prospect's last response below and categorize it as Green, Yellow, or Red based on these definitions: • **GREEN:** Clear desire for change, asking "next step" questions. (Action: Add to GPN Pipeline). • **YELLOW:** Interested but vague. (Action: Nurture with a soft follow-up). • **RED:** Just browsing, one-word replies. (Action: Release with respect). **Prospect's Response:** [PASTE MESSAGE HERE]. **Output:** Give me the Color Signal and the exact one-sentence reply I should send next.

Phase 4: The Handoff & Review

1. Permission vs. Booking (The "No-Pressure" Invite) You are not managing calendars. Your only job is to ask for **permission** to let the GPN team reach out.

Copy/Paste Prompt: **Role:** Professional connector. **Tone:** Calm, respectful, zero urgency. **Goal:** I need to ask a prospect for permission to have the GPN team contact them. **Instruction:** Write a short message that: 1. Acknowledges their interest in the system. 2. Explains that I don't handle the technical details myself. 3. Asks for simple permission for a Residual Income Advisor to reach out and answer their questions. **Key Phrase to include:** "I'm not booking an appointment; I'm just getting permission for the team to reach out."

2. Addressing the Cost (The Funding Explanation) : Use this prompt to confidently explain the **Funding Program**, which can cover business-building expenses for qualified members.

Copy/Paste Prompt: **Role:** Helpful peer in a home business community. **Tone:** Confident but friendly. **Instruction:** Write a short reply to someone asking about the cost. **Key Points to Cover:** 1. Explain that GPN's funding program can cover ongoing business-building expenses at no cost for qualified members. 2. Qualified members can get \$750 in their pocket to pay their business-building costs at ZERO cost to them. This is not a loan or financing, and it does not have to be repaid. 3. Invite them to a no-cost consultation where the Residual Income Advisor can handle the details.

3. The Two Paths (Pipeline vs. Link) : Offer both options so they feel in control: The "Concierge" option (Team reaches out) or the "Self-Directed" option (They book themselves).

Copy/Paste Prompt: Role: Supportive guide. **Instruction:** Write a message offering two simple paths forward: 1. Path A: I can have the team reach out to them directly (The "Concierge" option). 2. Path B: I can send them my personal link to explore and book when they are ready (The "Self-Directed" option). Link to use for Path B:

Phase 5: The Momentum Engine (The Weekly Review)

1. The "Only 3 Numbers" Scorecard: Use this prompt once a week to let AI act as your "Supportive Business Coach". It removes emotion and tells you exactly what to focus on next.

Copy/Paste Prompt: **Role:** Supportive business coach for a GPN member. **Tone:** Encouraging, practical, non-judgmental. **Instruction:** Review my activity for this week based on these 3 numbers: • 1. Invitations Sent: [INSERT NUMBER], • 2. Follow-ups Sent: [INSERT NUMBER], • 3. Posts Published: [INSERT NUMBER]. **Output:** Tell me: 1. What I did well this week. 2. What I should adjust slightly for next week. 3. The ONE thing I should focus on next to keep momentum.

2. Spotting the "Easy Win" (Bottleneck Breaker) : If you feel stuck, use this prompt to identify your "bottleneck" and the easiest fix.

Copy/Paste Prompt: **Role:** Business coach focused on momentum. **Tone:** Neutral and supportive. **Instruction:** I want to identify the "easy win" for next week. Based on my numbers below: • **Invitations:** [INSERT NUMBER]. • **Follow-ups:** [INSERT NUMBER]. • **Posts:** [INSERT NUMBER]. **Task:** Identify my current bottleneck and suggest the easiest fix for next week. Keep it to 2 short bullet points.

Conclusion: Your Messaging Engine

You now have a complete system that allows you to stop guessing and start building.

Remember, the goal of the **Minimal Effort AI Growth System** is not to make you a content creator or a salesperson. The goal is to let AI act as your "**consistent messaging engine**" so you can remain a "**friendly connector**".

By following the **Power Hour Lite** routine and using these prompts, you can grow your business in just **10–20 minutes a day**. You do not need to be intense; you just need to be consistent.

Think of these prompts as your **GPS coordinates**. The GPN system (the professional sales team and funding program) is the high-performance vehicle that drives you to residual income, but these prompts ensure you never get lost in a conversation.

Your Final Rule: "Your job ends at clarity. The system handles the rest".

You do not need to close deals, manage calendars, or convince anyone. You simply offer a path, ask for permission, and let the GPN team take over.

Trust the process. Let the AI remove the emotional labor. And let GPN do the heavy lifting.
